



**Fitting Instructions for RAD0163BK Radiator Guard**  
**HONDA XL700V TRANSALP '08-**



**In This Kit There Should Be**  
**2x Radiator Guard (RAD0163BK Left & Right)**  
**2x 100mm Lengths of self-adhesive Foam**

### **TOOLS REQUIRED**

- Socket set to include 10mm socket & wrench.

### **FITTING INSTRUCTIONS**

#### **Right Side (as you sit on the bike)**

- To fit the radiator guard to the bike cut the foam strip provided into 10mm wide pieces and stick them to the back of the radiator guard frame, so that they sit between the radiator guard and the radiator.
- Take the right sided radiator guard (*this can be identified by having the mounting hole on the right side of the radiator guard when looking at the front (logo facing towards you)*).
- Remove the bolt mounting the radiator in place, as arrowed in picture 1.
- Locate the R&G Radiator Guard into place, accessing the radiator from the front, locating the hooks around the edge and sliding downward into location, as shown in pictures 2 & 3.
- Re-fit the original bolt, ensuring it goes through the radiator guard mounting hole before locating into the threaded boss, as shown in picture 4.
- Ensure the radiator guard is correctly positioned before fully tightening the bolt.

*To fit the radiator guard on the left side of the bike, follow the same procedure.*

**Le kit doit contenir :**

- 2x Grille de protection (RAD0163BK gauche & droite)
- 2x 100mm Mousses autocollantes

#### **Outils requis**

Jeu de clés 10mm

#### **Instructions de montage**

##### **Coté droit**

- Couper la mousse en bandeaux de 10mm puis collez ces bandeaux au bas du support de protection radiateur, de façon à ce que ces bandeaux se situent entre la protection radiateur et le radiateur.
- Prendre la grille de protection coté droit (*elle peut être identifiée par son trou de fixation coté droit lorsque vous regarder le devant (le logo face à vous)*).
- Enlever le boulon qui fixe le radiateur en place (Photo 1).
- Placer la grille R&G en place, en accédant au radiateur par l'avant, en plaçant les crochets autour du bord et en la glissant vers le bas pour la mettre en position (Photos 2 & 3).
- Remettre le boulon d'origine, en veillant à ce qu'il aille dans le trou de fixation de la grille de protection, avant de le loger dans le trou fileté (Photo 4).
- Veiller à ce que la grille de protection soit correctement positionnée avant de serrer le boulon complètement.

*Suivre la même procédure pour installer la grille du coté gauche de la moto.*
