

FITTING INSTRUCTIONS FOR FP0095 FORK PROTECTORS KAWASAKI Z1000 2010



THIS KIT CONTAINS THE ITEMS PICTURED AND LABELLED BELOW. DO NOT PROCEED UNTIL YOU ARE SURE ALL PARTS ARE PRESENT.

Please note that the way the kit is packed does not necessarily represent the way of mounting to the bike

Please note that in cases where kits are packed with rubber washers holding the components onto the bolt – *the rubber washers should be thrown away*!

THE PARTS SHOWN MAY BE REPRESENTATIVE ONLY (FOR CLARITY OF INSTRUCTIONS ONLY)





TOOLS REQUIRED

- Socket set to include 2x 13mm sockets and wrenches
- Fit the spacer with the larger spigot into the hexagon shaped recess in right hand side of front spindle.
- Fit one nut and washer on spindle-bar (the end with shorter thread), engage the nut so the plastic insert of nut is fully engaged.
- Feed spindle-bar with nut and washer through either bobbin and through spindle spacer (from the right hand side) just fitted so larger diameter sits into large counter bore in back face of bobbin.
- Place remaining spacer with smaller spigot over exposed left hand end of spindle-bar so the smaller spigot locates in left hand side of spindle (so larger diameter sits into large counter bore in back face of bobbin).
- Fit washer and nut from kit onto thread and tighten until both nuts are engaged in nylon and equal amounts protrude from either side. Do not overtighten the nyloc nuts will hold it tight.

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
